

**Legal Support:**

- If you do not have a lawyer, you can speak with Legal Aid Ontario Duty Counsel, a free lawyer. The police will put you in touch with them.

- There are various provincially funded legal clinics across Toronto that provide legal counsel and support. You may qualify for free legal aid through Legal Aid Ontario (LAO). To retain a private lawyer, you can obtain a legal aid certificate for specific charges only from LAO by calling 1-800-668- 8258.
- This line can be difficult to navigate especially if you don't speak English. Deaf people could try Canada Video Relay Service to get through. They also have a toll-free TTY (teletypewriter) service at 1-866-641-8867 from Monday to Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. to communicate in English or French. If you wish to sue the police, you can find a civil lawyer who works on contingency fees (they will only receive money if you win
